

Press release:

In the light of recent developments, we hope that Europe is entering a new phase of free cooperation between our nations, unthinkable only a few years ago and still presenting grave difficulties.

The undersigned writers and artists from all parts of Europe have met in Amsterdam the 10-14 December, 1987, to add a concrete dimension to the agreements reached in Helsinki in the field of culture.

We now intend to establish an independent working body, called GULLIVER to collect, coordinate and promote ideas and projects incorporating this spirit of free cooperation.

Such an all-European working body could provide an opportunity for us Europeans, North and South, East and West, from large and small nations, to create a common future while respecting our diversity.
